Community Pharmacy Home Delivery Service during the Covid-19 outbreak

- 34. In England, from 1 August to 31 August 2020 a fee of £6 (this includes VAT) will be paid for each delivery to eligible patients as outlined in the updated version of the service specification for the Community Pharmacy Home Delivery Service during the Covid-19 outbreak.
- 35. The fees will be payable only to contractors meeting the requirements of the service as outlined in the updated version of the service specification available under the following link https://www.england.nhs.uk/coronavirus/primary-care/. Distance selling pharmacies are not eligible to provide this service.
- 36. Claims for payments for this service should be made monthly, via the MYS platform provided by the NHSBSA no later than the 5th of the following month.
- 37. The NHSBSA will make appropriate payments claimed by the pharmacy contractor as described above, in the same payment month as other payments for the related NHS Pharmaceutical Services and the payments will be separately itemised on the FP34 Schedule of Payments.
- 38. Local pharmaceutical services (LPS) pharmacies should note that a contract variation will apply to them to commission as appropriately a similar service from them.
