

How to manage a contract in NHS Jobs user guide

This guide gives you instructions for how to manage a contract in the NHS Jobs service.

Once you've issued a contract to an applicant, you can choose one of the following options:

- accept the contract on the applicant's behalf
- wait for the applicant to respond to the contract
- edit and then resend the contract
- withdraw the job offer and the contract

To find out which roles can do this, go to the '**Roles and permissions**' link in the '**Help and information**' section of the <u>employer dashboard</u>.




