What's New in ePACT2

National Medicines Optimisation Opportunities dashboard

The new National Medicines Optimisation Opportunities dashboard has been developed with NHS England (NHSE) to bring together data to support the <u>national medicines optimisation opportunities 2023/24</u>. It includes metrics to support nine of the opportunity areas described in the NHSE guidance and we will add more when we can.

Alerts dashboard – co-prescribing of tramadol and warfarin

A new comparator has been added to the Alerts dashboard for co-prescribing of tramadol and warfarin, following the release of <u>Susan Gladstone: Prevention of future deaths report</u>.

BNF code changes - January 2024

The annual version changes relating to the BNF structure have been implemented with January 2024 dispensing data. As ePACT2 always uses the latest BNF code, the BNF code as of January 2024 onwards will also apply to all historical data.

The latest file shows the BNF presentation code as of December 2023 data against the BNF presentation code as of January 2024 data. Also included is the presentation name that aligns with these changes.

If you are using any of the older version BNF codes stated within an analysis filter then the filter will need changing with the new BNF codes added to

capture those presentations.

Changes to monthly data stored within ePACT2

After the upcoming refresh for February 2024's data in ePACT2, users will notice that the earliest data available to access will be February 2014. This reflects the data transitioning to a 120 month (10 year) rolling dataset.

Therefore, for each subsequent month's data that is added into ePACT2, the earliest month will be removed to stay within the 120 rolling cycle.
