<u>Disclosure of Senior Manager's remuneration: Greenbury 2025</u>

We anticipate that the Greenbury functionality within Pensions Online (POL) will be available from Monday 13 January 2025. Requests for disclosure information should be received by NHS Pensions between 13 January 2025 and 28 February 2025 to enable us to provide you with the necessary disclosure information to meet your reporting timescales.

Key points to note:

- take care to provide the best estimated pay figure, as you can only make one submission
- you should avoid using the comments box on POL unless necessary, as this
 prevents cases running through the system automatically which could cause a
 delay in your response
- employment should be updated to 31 March 2024. Make sure you have checked this before you submit, as this will cause a delay to us processing your calculations
- we do not anticipate any queries from you until you have received your calculation, as these will also cause a delay to our processing. If you then

- have a query about an individual member, please submit on the POL comments box
- if a member was part of the exercise last year, the previous year's figures will be available to view by pressing the 'show/compare button'
- if a member did not receive a calculation last year, please do not request last year's figures until you have received our reply for this year
- we received several queries asking for help with technical POL issues. If you have any similar issues, call the Employer Helpline on 0300 330 1353 (press option 2 for POL)
- if you require a detailed understanding of the calculation, please refer to the technical link on our website which will soon be updated

Partial retirement - backdated pay awards

Backdated annual pay awards, or pay increases members received as they move through pay scales, do not count towards the reduction in pay that they have taken

for partial retirement purposes. However, any pay increase resulting from a contractual change to their terms and conditions will count towards this.

For example, if a member decides to apply for a different job with a higher salary, increase their hours or increase their commitments, this will affect the reduction and could result in the pension being fully abated.

Following the nationally agreed pay award, which has been backdated to April 2024, the pay for any retirements from that date will need revising to ensure the pension is being paid at the correct level. For partial retirements, where pay cannot be updated through Pensions Online (POL), the figures will need to be submitted to us manually.

Due to the number of members this affects, and to mitigate the workload for you, we will be sending you a pre-populated spreadsheet with the members of your organisation that have retired on or after 1 April 2024. You will be asked to complete this spreadsheet with the revised pay details and submit it to us via email. We will then update the member records using the information you provide and process the revised benefits. The emails will be sent out in December.
